

Remarks on Board Addison

Thursday 11th First part of this day light air & calm
Lying at anchor. Mr. & Latter parts
the same. — trading for coconuts
bananas, pigs, fowls &c

Friday 12th All of this day light air & calm
Lying at anchor as above. got off
3 boat loads of wood.

Saturday 13th First part of this day light air & calm
& calm. Lying at anchor as above
got off 4 boat loads of wood.
Mr. & Latter parts the same.
got off 5 boat loads of wood.

Sunday 14th All of this day light easterly winds
& calm. Lying at anchor as above

Monday 15th All of this day light air & calm
got off 7 boat loads of wood some
hops &c

Tuesday 16th First part of this day light air &
calm. At 5 P.M. got underway
for Peamua valley. Dominique Island,
with Station Missionary O'Leary & Smith
as passengers. Mr. & Latter parts
moderate N. E. to E. N. E. breeze
& pleasant.

Wednesday 16th At 2 P.M. arrived off Peamua
valley & sent ashore O'Leary & landed
& traded for some bananas & sweet
potatoes. Lay off & on through the
night. At 11 A.M. O'Leary the mission-
ary at this valley & the head one of
the group came aboard to buy cloth
Capice &c. — Lying off & on. All ship
in Passua, nothing this season. over
the voyage.

Thursday 17th First part fresh E. trades, at 4
P.M. finished trading & left the
island steering to the N. W. till
sunset — then took in light sails &
came to the wind S. by E.
Mr. & Latter parts the same. At daylight
steamed off to the westward. Several islands
in sight.

Friday 18th First part of this day light E. N. E.
trades & pleasant. Churned N. W. At
sunset got down to the island of
Rooapoh & came to the wind S. by E.
Mr. & Latter parts light air from N.
standing in all of A.M. for Rooapoh
Law papriets. At Ends
