Saturday
Feb 26th

First part of this day light air from E. & pleasant — Off the island of Rorapoah. At 3 P.M. sent in Lt. B. to trade for hogs — At sunset returned could not get any & had one of the Brabo crew a Kanaka (Johnny Boy) to run away. Left off M. & Latter parts fine breeze from N. E. Comm. N. N. W. passed Nukira & Roberts island. Saw porpoises

Sunday First part fine trades N. E. & E. 31st Comm. N. N. W. with all sail set. M. & Latter parts the same

Lat Obs 6° 10'

Monday All of this day fine trades from 32nd E. N. E. & pleasant. Steering by the wind to the N. E. with all sail set. Employed in beating out & stowing off two decks.

Long Obs 142° 38'

Tuesday First part of this day fine E. N. E. & 33rd pleasant. Steering by the wind to the N. E. M. & Latter parts light E. winds & pleasant. Steering by the wind to the N. E. Employed in stowing off two decks. Mending sails &c.

Near the Line

February 1858

Wednesday 34th First part light E. wind & pleasant. Steering by the wind to the N. E. M. & Latter parts the same. Stowed some two decks. Painted spauls &c.

Thursday 35th First part of this day moderate breeze from E. & pleasant. Steering by the wind to the N. E. with all sail set. M. & Latter parts the same. Copper setting up "pips" others employed in rigging &c.

Lat Obs 2° 00'

Friday 36th First part of this day moderate breeze from E. & pleasant. Steering as above. Saw porpoises. M. & Latter parts the same & employed the same

Lat Obs 3° 30'
Long Obs 142° 21'

Saturday 37th First part moderate E. trades & pleasant. Steering by the wind to the N. E. with all sail set. At 3 P.M. found three boats for a small shoal of Black-fish without success. M. & Latter parts the same. Broke out four Peak to slow Pips.
