

Remarks On Board Addison

Sunday 28th First part fresh breeze from E. & overcast weather. Steering by the wind to the N. E. At 7 P.M. kept off N. by W. for the S. I. & latter part fresh breeze from E. N. E. At 8 A.M. set a topmast studdsail.

Lat Obs. $5^{\circ}50'$

Monday Comes in with fresh breeze from N. E. At 4 P.M. took in fly jib & studdsail. M. strong winds. At 9 P.M. took in topgallants & at 4 A.M. parted the M. topsail. Sheet & double reefed the topsails. Latter part the same.

Lat Obs. $8^{\circ}28'$ Long Obs. $144^{\circ}30'$

Tuesday 29th First part strong breeze from N. E. Steering N. W. under double reefed topsails & courses. At 4 P.M. more moderate set. topgallants over single reefed topsails. Saw a Fin-back. M. & latter part the same.

Lat Obs. $10^{\circ}48'$ Long Obs. $146^{\circ}18'$

Wednesday 30th First part strong N. E. breeze - course N. W. by N. with topgallants over single reefed topsails.

M. & latter part the same. Stowed off casks in M. hold.

Lat Obs. $13^{\circ}32'$ Long Obs. $147^{\circ}53'$

Bound for Sandwich Islands March 1858

Thursday 31st First part strong breeze from N. E. with passing clouds. Course N. W. by N. under sail as before. M. & latter part the same. Broke out in after hold to get empty casks & separate things.

Lat Obs. $16^{\circ}18'$ Long Obs. $149^{\circ}55'$

Friday 1st First part fresh breeze from E. N. E. & pleasant. Course N. W. by W. At 5 P.M. made all sail. M. & latter part fresh breeze & somewhat squally. Course N. W. by W. employed in washing ship &c.

Lat Obs. $18^{\circ}15'$ Long Obs. $152^{\circ}31'$

Saturday 2nd First part fresh breeze from N. E. & pleasant. Course N. W. by N. with all sail set. M. & latter part the same. At 10 A.M. saw Oahu being S. W. est. dist. 60 miles.

Lat Obs. $20^{\circ}22'$ Long Obs. $155^{\circ}12'$

Sunday 3rd First part moderate breeze from N. E. & pleasant. Course N. W. by N. Oahu on the beam & one sail on the larboard side. At daylight rounded the point for Maui anchorage. Fresh E. N. E. breeze.
