

Remarks on Board Ship Addison, 1858.

Monday
Mch 8th

Ice of this day light air & calms under the lee of Maui. At 1 P.M. arrived at the anchorage & came to in 17 fathoms water. Landed 10 or 11 ship's men. The Drs A. L. Cox, Pike, Rossau, John Coggeshall, Henry & Gen. Hillman, Lagoda, Tenados, Sharons, &c got ashore & raft of water cast &c.

Tuesday
9th

Ice of this day light air variable & calm & pleasant weather. All hands employed getting off water &c. So ends.

Wednesday
10

Ice of this day light air variable & pleasant. All hands employed getting off water &c.

Thursday
Mch. 11th & 12th & 13th & 14th

Going at Maui - receiving ship - getting water, giving liberty &c &c. Discharged Mr St John (2nd officer) sick - & Mch. 15th James Brown (3rd officer) joined the ship & Mr Chappell former 3rd officer, promoted to 2nd mate. - Ship going & Gen, Long, of Manchester burned.

16th & 17th Going as above. Sent ashore & sold by Gauges on board (2167) twenty one hundred & sixty seven gallons whale oil.

19th & 20th Going as before & getting ready for sea.

Mch 21st

Heighed anchor at 4 P.M. with strong trade - double reefed the topsails & stood for Oahu. While in port we discharged Mr St John & Gifford (coalsteerer) & shipped 8 hands viz 5 Kanakas & 3 white men -

From Maui to Arctic Ocean Mch. 1858.

Mch 21st

Continued - At 8 A.M. got down to Oahu & Capt & wife went ashore. It being Sunday lay off & on. Did nothing.

Monday
Mch 22nd

All of this day strong trade - going off & on under double reefed topsails. 8 to 10 ships down the same. Latter part employed in heaving off chain cable in 15 fath. lengths. So ends.

Tuesday
23rd

Ice of this day strong trade - going off & on under double reefed topsails. Employed in heaving off chain & ashore to be. Shipped 17 barrels weighing 1362 lbs by ship Eliza & Ella, for N. Bedford. So ends -

Wednesday
24th

Ice of this day strong trade, going off & on as above. At 2 P.M. Capt Clam aboard & we squared away N. by E. made sail, stood anchor &c.

Thursday
25th

All of this day strong trade from E. N. E. & pleasant. Caught 10 lb fish with all drawing sail set - Employed getting boats making spun-yarn &c.
