Friday All of this day strong trades from E. by N. & rough. Course N. with all sail set. Sailed N. boat, & the span boat made spun-yarn &c.

Saturday

27th All of this day fine trades from E. with pleasant weather. Employed making spun-yarn, & putting on rigging &c.

Lat Obs. $22^{\circ} 35'$

Long Chr. $170^{\circ} 04'$

Sunday

28th All of this day light winds from E. S. E. & pleasant. Course N. with all sail set. Employed at various jobs.

Lat Obs. $22^{\circ} 49'$

Long Chr. $171^{\circ} 27'$

Monday

29th Came in with light airs from E. S. E. & fine clear weather. Course N. with all sail set. M. & Latter parts the same. Wash day. Started water.

Lat Obs. $23^{\circ} 14'$

Tuesday

30th All of this day fine trades from E. Course N. by N. with all sail set. Sent a new fore & m. topsails. Second hand job, do. Clove mizen.

Lat Obs. $24^{\circ} 20'$

Long Chr. $175^{\circ} 50'$

Towards Arctic Ocean April 1858

Wednesday

31st First part fine breeze from E. & pleasant. Course N. by N. with all sail set. M. & Latter parts the same. Employed putting on rigging.

Lat Obs. $25^{\circ} 02'$

Long Chr. $178^{\circ} 15'$

Thursday

1st First part light airs from E. S. E. & very pleasant. Course N. N. by N. M. & Latter parts light airs & calms. Sent the new m. spencer, rattled to make rigging.

Lat Obs. $26^{\circ} 04'$

Friday

2nd First part light airs Easting & calms. Course N. N. by N. M. part light breeze & some rain. At 11 A.M. a breeze from N. by N. stood by the wind to the N. & saw a fin-back. Stowed down some pipes & hoisted up some sheets.

3rd First part moderate breeze from N. At 4 P.M. it hauled round to N. by E. Course N. N. by N. with all sail set. M. & Latter parts wind E. & fine weather. Course N. by N. made a fore stay sail out of new spanker.
