

Remarks on Board *Adelphi* April 1853

Sunday
April 4th First part fine breeze from E. S. E. & pleasant. — Course S. by W. with all sail set. — M. & latter part moderate breeze from S. & pleasant. — Saw a Turtle.

Lat 40° 30' 20"

Monday First part moderate breeze from S. S. W. & pleasant. Course S. by W. M. part fine breeze from S. W. & foggy. Course S. by W. with all sail set. At 7 A.M. wind moderated to a calm with thick rainy weather & so ends the day. Saw no signs.

No. 10.

Tuesday
6th First part thick rainy weather. At 4 P.M. a heavy squall up from the N. but still thick. At 6 P.M. double reefed the Topsails. — M. part the same only wind veered to the E. & plenty of rain. Latter part wind S. E. made sail — Course S. by W.

Lat 40° 35' 27"

Wednesday
7th Comes in with fresh & increasing wind from S. E. At 6 P.M. shortened sail to a double reefed M. Topsail & staysails & came to the wind heading E. S. E. M. same. Latter part strong winds from N. N. W. & clear. made sail heading to the N. E. Saw nothing.

Lat 40° 34' 00"
Long 179° 30' 00"

Towards Arctic Ocean April 1853

Thursday
8th Comes in with strong breeze from S. W. & clear. steering by the wind to the N. E. At 4 P.M. let Hauling on & squared shanks sail to a double reefed M. Topsail & staysails. M. the same. Latter part a little more moderate. At daylight set a double reefed fore & M. Topsail. Heading N. N. E. No. 10.

Friday
9th First part strong breeze from S. W. with passing clouds. At 2 P.M. were ship to the N. E. At 6 A.M. set jib & mainsail. M. part more moderate & from N. E. turned the reef out. — Course S. W. Latter part wind blew from E. set M. Topgallant.

Lat 40° 36' 00"

Saturday
10th First part fresh breeze from E. S. E. with cloudy weather. Course S. W. by W. with all sail set. — M. part wind increased to a gale with thick rainy weather. took in sail to a double reefed fore & M. Topsail & staysails. wind S. E. Latter part same. No. 10.

Sunday
11th First part a gale from S. E. with thick rainy weather — under sail as above. — Course S. W. by W. M. part moderated & at 3 A.M. calm. At 8 A.M. a moderate breeze sprang up from S. W. & fog cleared. made all sail. Course as before.
