

Remarks on Board Ship Addison

Monday

20th First part light airs from E. N. E. & pleasant weather - Course S. W. by N. with all sail set. M. & Latter parts moderate breeze from S. E. with overcast weather. Went to the old & built a new Foul-ail.

Tuesday

21st First part moderate breeze from S. E. with overcast weather. Course S. W. by N. M. part brisk breeze. Latter part fresh breeze from S. E. At 7 A.M. kept her N. saw 2 Camp larks & 3 Fin larks.

At 10.

Wednesday

22nd First part fresh breeze from S. E. & foggy. At 7 A.M. kept her N. then shortened sail to double reefed M. Toppail & Staysails & came to the wind heading to the S. E. M. same. At 7 A.M. kept off N. W. At 11 A.M. wind veered to the S. fog lifted & we made our sail.

Long 166° 23'

Thursday

23rd First part light breeze from S. W. & clear till 4 P.M. then for sail down - saw 2 Fin larks. At 7 P.M. shortened sail to double reefed Staysails - M. part wind burst up from S. E. with thick & rainy weather. At 7 A.M. was ship to the N. & so ends

At 10.

Towards Arctic Ocean April 1858

Friday

23rd First part a moderate gale from S. E. with thick, rainy weather. Steering by the wind to the N. W. At sunset shortened sail to double reefed M. Toppail & Staysails. M. & Latter parts moderate breeze from S. E. & foggy. At 9 A.M. made our sail heading to the N. E. fog cleared by 10.

At 10.

Saturday

24th First part moderate breeze from S. E. & foggy, steering by the wind to the N. W. At 7 A.M. larked to the E. M. & Latter parts light airs from S. E. & calms - steering by the wind to the N. E.

At 10.

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Sunday

25th First part light airs from S. E. & thick fog heading E. with all sail set. M. part fresh breeze from S. E. Latter part strong breeze from S. E. & veering to the S. thick weather. Course S. E. with all sail set.

At 10.

Monday

26th First part strong breeze from S. W. to S. E. & cloudy - no fog. Course S. E. At 7 P.M. took in S. Toppail & Staysails. E. N. E. saw a Fin lark. M. & Latter parts fresh breeze from N. N. W. & cloudy - saw nothing.
