Sun. Remains on Board. Addison June 1858

Monday
First part fresh breeze from S.W. & thick w.
being black among the ice under double
ruffed topsails. - Saw several ships doing the
same. M. & Latter parts the same. We
are in a quite large clear place among
the ice. By ships in the same place -

Tuesday
First part moderate S.W. wind & thick
weather. - Lay as above. 4 P.M. Capt.
boarded for an hour ship Omega before
spoken. M. the same. At 8
A.M. the wind veered to the N.W. &
freshened, made all sail & stood
in various directions - Saw 3 or 4
ships. Lat 61° 54'

Wednesday
Came in with moderate breeze from
S.W. & pleasant steering to the E. 3 P.M.
it came on foggy - Came to the wind
& shortened sail.
M. & Latter parts fresh breeze from S.W. with
thick weather. - Steering by the wind back &
forth & sometimes black gaining with
the morning. -

Friday
First part strong S.W. wind & thick with
working to windward among the ice.
M. & Latter parts a calm from S.W. & thick
weather; working to windward under
close ruffed topsails. Lat 62°

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Near Cape Thaddeus. June 1858

Tuesday
All of this day fresh breeze from
S.W. with overcast hazy weather. Latter
part made all sail heading in for
Cape Thaddeus - saw 3 ships.
Lat 62° 29'
Long 139°

Wednesday
First part fresh breeze from S.W. with
overcast hazy weather. 3 P.M. arrived
within 8 miles of Cape Thaddeus & stood
off shore. At 7 P.M. spoke ship Chas.
Whitcomb. M. & Latter parts fresh breeze from S.W. with
thick weather. Took in sail to double ruffed
topsails. Lat 62°

Thursday
Came in with wind S.W. moderate
& clearing up. made all sail. At 11
P.M. wind increased for a 13. Head run
quick to the E. N. E. without much
saw several sails. At 7 P.M. a moderate
breeze from S.W. & fine weather - heading
N. E. for Cape Narain. 10 miles dist. -
M. part fresh breeze from N.W. Latter part
the same. saw several sails. (and from
10 to 40 miles dist. Lat. 62° 22'

Friday
First part light baffling wind - till 4 P.M.
then a moderate breeze from S.W. 8 P.M.
a 13. Head came up close to the ship & stopped
between the boats but did not see him again. 2 A.M.
saw N. & L. boats for a whale going quick & chase
but succ. 3 do. towards S. & 13. boats for another
N. little 9 do. towards 2 boats again got nothing.
and going N. E. Cape Narain N. dist. 40 miles -
