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Remarks on Board Addison. 1838

Sunday

July 18th Strong N.E. wind had to let go our 3rd anchor to keep from dragging. Arrived & anchored South America. Breeze - beating 4, strokes per hour.

Monday

July 19th First part a gale N.E. cloudy then at anchor. M. part more moderate gale underweigh & run off to the S. of St. Lawrence. Saw one Bow Head going quick to the N.E. did not lower. 6 ships in sight. Land from 8 to 25 miles dist.

Tuesday

July 20th Strong wind from N. near the chime. 15 ships in sight - 6 A.M. kept off for Marcus Bay with strong wind. Refused Topsyails.

Lat 64° 45'

Wednesday

July 21st All of this day hard gales from N. & clear weather. 4 P.M. passed Indian Point & off it saw 3 or 4 Bow Heads going quick to windward. Sd. hauled in & anchored in mouth of Marcus Bay - found bark Harmony going here. 9 P.M. let go the 3rd anchor - 20 strokes per hour.

Thursday

July 22nd Comes in with a gale - 4 P.M. gale abated took our anchors & began working back to the N. - M. & L. part foggy 10 A.M. - gale with ship Champion, Coffin - nothing this season.

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Cruising Around Cape 1838

Friday

July 23rd First part moderate breeze from E. with spells of fog. 6 P.M. lowered in company with Champion's boat for Humpbacks without success. M. & L. part moderate breeze from N.E. & foggy. No bls.

Saturday

July 24th All of this day moderate breeze from N. & part of the time foggy, working up toward St. Lawrence Bay. - saw the bark & crew. Looking out better. No bls.

Sunday

July 25th Light airs from N. & calm - with some rain. Off St. Lawrence Bay 30 miles. saw 4 ships. gale with ships Speedwell, Marry's Champion & Captain Court.

Monday

July 26th First part light airs from N. & pleasant. Land 20 miles dist. M. part fresh winds from N. N.E. with rain - double reefed the Topsyails. Heaving to the E. L. part more moderate - made all sail heading E. saw many "Musca" tippers. Look about as usual.

Tuesday

July 27th All day fresh winds from N. & clear. Strong N. by E. Off St. Lawrence Bay. 8 P.M. spoke French ship "Stic" nothing.
