 Aug 22nd 1858 Gale abated to a calm by 7 P.M.
 M. & Latta parts moderate breeze from
 E. - saw several ships & some whales
 going quick chased without success
 fishing

Monday Light air variable & some rain -
 23rd P.M. chased whales without success
 A.M. saw no Bow Heads but plenty
 of "Muske Cigges" & 8 or 10 Sails - finished
 fishing

Tuesday First part fresh winds from N.E. & S.W.
 24th of fog - saw "Cigges" 3 P.M. spoke &
 engaged with bark Mary & Susan of N.B.
 9 wh. - M. & Latta parts a gale from N.E.
 & raining, under short sail 700 strokes

Wednesday Comes in with a gale N.E. & thick rain
 25th weather. M. & Latta parts moderate winds
 & foggy. 6 A.M. began stowing down in
 after-hold - saw one sail.

Thursday First part light air from N.E. & raining
 26th stowing down - saw 9 sails. M. & Latta
 parts fresh breeze & rough. A.M. saw a
 good many whales & chased by spears
 all day. 8 A.M. M. B. fastened slightly
 & presently drew her line

 Thursday
 Aug. 27th 1858 Fresh breeze & cloudy. saw several
 whales going quick - chased without success
 5 A.M. loaded for one more do. do.
 saw several ships.

Friday
 28th First part moderate breeze from S.E. cloudy
 with a little rain, - saw no whales
 M. & Latta parts light air & calms - said
 "M. Cigges" & firing 2 Boats 450 strokes

Saturday
 29th First part moderate breeze from N.E. & S.W.
 3 P.M. loaded for a Bow Head which
 L.D. got & took alongside at 6 do. got
 ready for cutting - while cutting was
 spoken by ship N.E. & S.W. 19 wh. &
 bark Mary & Susan 9 wh. - M. & Latta
 parts strong winds from do. finished
 cutting. 600 strokes.

Sunday Strong winds from N.E. - saw some
 30th ships but no whales. 3 P.M. began firing

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Monday
 31st Wind from N.E. & N.W. strong in
 various directions 8 A.M. saw the land
 to the S. of Bay Cape - stowed away from
 it. 500 strokes.
