

Remarks On Board Addition Sept 10th

Friday Sept 10th 1838 First part fresh winds from Eth & clear. Steering S. by N. along shore from E. Cape - Sunset saw a ship ahead. M. & latter part lights air from Eth overcast weather. Land 14 to 20 miles dist.

Saturday Light air from Eth & cloudy - came 11th S. by N. 10. Am. passed Indian point saw 3 ships going as we are. 400 strokes

Sunday Wind from E. S. E. to S. S. W. 12th came S. S. E. sunset passed St. Lawrence island leaving it on S. hand 18 miles dist. Came S. by E. saw many Hou- -backs - 500 strokes

Lat 61° 43'

Monday First part light breeze from Sth & 13th cloudy. 1 P.M. saw Gue's island 2 points on E. hand 50 miles dist. I departed the S. part of it. 20 miles dist. 11 P.M. came to the wind & lay till daylight & then kept off S. E. with fine breeze S. W. - Land at noon bearing E. 18 miles dist. 400 strokes -

Passage To Bristol Bay, Sept 1838

Tuesday Sept 14th 1838 First & M. part fresh breeze from N. S. W. came S. E. 2 P.M. saw 2 Right wh. going very quick to windward - At sunset saw Gue's Pinnacles islands out of sight on the lee quarter. Latter part fine breeze S. W. came E. by S. employed scraping line 200 strokes.

Lat 60° 38' 00"
