

Remarks on Board Addison Sept

Wednes.

Sept 22<sup>nd</sup> First part fresh & increasing breeze from S. & cloudy. Steering N. by E. with all sail set. At 7 P.M. took in sail to draw upon topsails, but the Comm. & line ship to the S. E. - saw Fin backs. M. part fresh gale from do. & raining. joined the Fin topsail - Latter part more moderate & foggy. Pumped 200 strokes. No obs.

Thurs.

23<sup>rd</sup> First part light breeze from S. to S. E. & thick fog - being under short sail heading to the S. E. M. & Latter parts light air & calm. 11 Am. the fog cleared up & gave us fine weather - Caught 1 Cod fish. Set Stakes

Lat obs. 57° 05'

Friday

24<sup>th</sup> First part light air from N. E. & calm. Pleasant weather - Comm. S. E. M. M. part light air from N. E. Comm. S. N. by S. Latter part fresh breeze from E. & Comm. S. N. & S. N. by W. - 100 strokes

Lat obs. 56° 19'

From Bristol Bay to S. Islands. Sept 1853

Monday Sept 25<sup>th</sup> First part fresh breeze from E. & cloudy. Comm. N. E. N. by S. P.M. we then saw St George Island on our S. beam 25 min. dist. & stood S. by N. & P.M. took in topsails & do. double reefed the topsail. M. part moderating some, made whole topsails. Comm. S. by E. Latter part being on 9 Am. reefed again. 600 strokes. Lat obs. 54° 12' Long Obs. 171° 34'

Tuesday

26<sup>th</sup> First part fresh breeze from E. & cloudy. Comm. S. by E. - set whole M. topsail & M. topsails. M. part under the topsails. At 12 M. tacked to the N. & 3 Am. tacked to the S. E. At daylight saw 2 ships & 1 big all bound through - wind very strong in puffs from E. N. E. - 9 Am. spoke & gave with ship 1 sign of rocks for this reason. 11 Am. saw an Island on E. side of "Leontine" passage with it on E. by S. 10 min. dist. - reefed the topsails. Lat obs. 52° 29'

Wednesday

27<sup>th</sup> First part strong winds from E. N. E. with thick overcast weather - Comm. S. E. by S. under all present sail. M. part strong winds from N. E. & raining. double reefed the topsails. Latter part wind E. N. E. & more moderate with fog - 1200 strokes. No obs.
