Remarks On Board Bark S. Thers.
Tuesday All of this day fine trade
16th from Est Steady to the Sth with
all sail set. Employed at various
jobs Pumped 900 stks. Lat 18° 35'

Wednesday All of this day fine trade from
17th Est to Sth Mr. Thers. the island
of Whittake bearing N. dist 35 miles
and down to it arriving at dark
then hauled to the wind & lay off
in — at 9 am. Capt went ashore
with two boats to get recruits.

Thursday Lay off on as above — got 3 boats
18th loads of wood, also some coconuts
Pigs, fowls, ducks, oranges, pine apples
Bananas &c. At 5 pm. the Capt
came aboard & we made sail &
steamed S. — Mr. & Latter parts strong
winds & raining. Shortened sail to
double reefed wind E. to E. N. E.
800 stks. Notes.

Friday All of this day strong wind
19th from Est & north — Calm S. & W.
under sail as above — half sick
800 stks.

Saturday All of this day strong wind as
20th above — under sail as do.
doing little jobs. 800 stks.

Long Obs. 164° 15'

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Sunday
21st 1858. First part strong wind from Est
& cloudy. Steady to the wind to the
Sth under double reefed topsails & courses.
Lift in. Mr. & Latter parts the same
1500 stks

Lat Obs. 27° 28'
Long Obs. 164° 54'

Monday Came in with wind E. S. E. with
22nd falling clouds — under sail as above
11 pm. turned the reefs out of Mr. Latter
set the jib. — Mr. & Latter parts.
moderate — made all sail —
Began rattling lower rigging.
Not struck Lat Obs. 29° 10'

Tuesday All of this day moderate
23rd winds from N. E. Latter part some
rain — under S. E. all sail set.
200 stks
Lat Obs. 30° 53'

Wednesday First part moderate winds various
24th some rain. Mr. & Latter parts
moderate breeze from S. S. E. pleasant
rattling lower rigging.
1100 stks. Lat Obs. 31° 48'
Long Obs. 164° 01'
