1st 25th 1858 First part fine breeze from S. E. W. pleasant - steering by the wind to the S. E. - went out the fore sprit & bent a spare one - finished patching down rigging - Mr. & Latta parts moderate breeze from N. E. - 1000 strokes. Lat 33° 23' Long 163° 50' (We saw to-day. 3) (Saw 2 Sads) (Saw 2 Sads)

Friday

2nd 26th All of this day moderate breeze from S. E. W. pleasant - Course S. E. - saw 2 Fin-backs. - 600 strokes. Lat 35° 01' Long 163° 53'

Saturday

3rd 27th First part light winds from S. E. W. pleasant - Course as above - obtained the fore sprit partly unbuttoned - Mr. the same. Latta part light winds from S. E. overcast weather. 600 strokes. Lat 36° 37'

Sunday

4th 28th Comes in with light S. E. wind & cloudy - tacked to the S. E. W. - Mr. part wind E. - Course S. by E. - Latta part light winds from S. E. - saw Fin-backs. 600 strokes. Notes

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Bound for New Zealand. 1858

Sunday

1st 29th 1858 First part light winds from North - spells of fog. Saw 2 Hens. Mr. & Latta parts light winds from S. E. & cloudy - standing by the wind to the E. at 9 A.M. rose & Latta for a Right whale - gave 200 but dodging about a good deal under water. At 11.30. came aboard without success. 500 strokes. Notes. Lat 38° 30' Long 163° 00'

Tuesday

2nd 30th First part moderate breeze from S. E. W. at 12.30 tacked to the S. E. & after some time for the same whale chased in A.M. & chased him again 3 hours without success. Mr. & Latta parts fresh breeze from S. E. at 11 A.M. spoke & gammed with Bark Architect of St. London Fish. nothing this season. Lat 39° 18' Long 163° 01'

Wednesday

3rd 31st 1858 - All of this day fresh breeze from S. E. - cruising for whales. At 8 A.M. lowered for 2 & chased without success. P.M. spoke Ship Jefferson & W.B. - Lat 39° 07' Long 162° 50'

Thurs.

4th 1st All of this day moderate breeze from S. E. at 6 P.M. lowered for 3 wh. E. B. got one & took him to the ship at 7.30. got ready for cutting - daylight began cutting. finishing at 8 P.M. made sail & steamed by the wind. Lat 39° 01'
