Monday Aug 18th Comes in with strong wind from N. E. & S. E. & cloudy - calm E. M. & latter parts the same. 2000 strokes. Lat 48° 45' Long Chs. 134° 30'

19th All of this day a gale from N. E. & S. E. & squally - shortened sail to double reefed topsails. 1600 Lat 48° 45' Long Chs. 135° 00'

Wednesday Comes in with a gale from N. E. & S. E. & squally - calm E. & S. E. M. & latter parts the same. 1800 Lat 49° 35' Long Chs. 125° 46'

Thursday All of this day fresh wind from N. E. & S. E. & pleasant. Set all sail - calm E. & S. E. & raised the foresail. 1500 Lat 49° 59' Long Chs. 122° 19'

Friday First part fine breeze from N. E. & S. E. & pleasant. M. & latter parts a gale from N. E. & S. E. & squally - calm E. & S. E. & raised the topsails. 1400 Lat 50° 07' Long Chs. 118° 54'

Sunday Aug 23rd First part fresh breeze from N. E. & S. E. & pleasant - calm E. & S. E. & made all sail. Saw nothing. M. & latter parts thick wind from N. E. & S. E. - 1400 strokes. Lat 50° 07' Long Chs. 118° 54'

Monday All of this day strong wind from N. E. & S. E. & thick - calm E. & S. E. - 1400 strokes. M. & latter parts the same. Lat 50° 07' Long Chs. 118° 54'

Tuesday First part a very strong breeze from N. E. & S. E. & thick weather - calm E. & S. E. & latter parts the M. & S. E. sail short time & double reefed the topsails. M. & latter parts moderate made all sail. 1800 strokes. Lat 50° 25' Long Chs. 118° 24'

Wednesday All of this day strong wind from N. E. & S. E. & squally - calm E. & S. E. & double reefed the topsails. Calm E. & S. E. M. & latter parts pleasant made all sail. 1800 strokes. Lat 54° 08' Long Chs. 101° 55'

Thursday First part fresh breeze from N. E. & S. E. & pleasant. M. & latter parts the same. Calm E. & S. E. & raised the topsails. 1800 strokes. Lat 54° 47' Long Chs. 98° 25'
