

Settings (Down) Evenings July 1859

Wednes.

July 18th Comes in with strong wind from N. N. W. & cloudy - Course Ch. N. E. - 7 P.M. (Sunset) Raised up the topsail & came to the wind. Daylight kept off E. N. E. saw a sail going S. 800 strokes
Lat Obs. 50° 45'
Long Obs. 62° 40'

Thurs. All of this day fine breeze from N. N. W. & pleasant - Course E. N. E. saw 13 sails going S. Sunset shortened sail at daylight made sail & kept off to the E. 800 strokes Lat Obs. 50° 13'
Long Obs. 61° 39'

Friday All of this day fine breeze from N. N. W. to N. W. Saw five backs - steering to the E. Sunset shortened sail & at daylight made it again & steered E. N. E. till 9 A.M. then came to the wind N. N. E. 800 strokes
Lat Obs. 50° 32'

Saturday First part fresh breeze from N. W. steering as above - shortened sail at sunset - saw 1 sail going S. - Daylight made sail with a fine breeze from N. N. W. came N. by E. -
Lat Obs. 49° 40'

Sunday First part fine breeze from N. N. W. came N. by E. saw five backs - sunset shortened sail. Daylight made all sail & steered N. by E. saw five backs.
for strokes. Lat Obs. 48° 35'
Long Obs. 58° 00'

Leaving & Regaining Inward Bound July 1859

Monday

July 21st Comes in with fresh breeze from N. W. steering by the wind to the N. N. E. Sunset shortened sail. Daylight made sail heading N. by E. 600 strokes. Lat Obs. 49° 41'

Tuesday

July 22nd First part fresh breeze from N. W. steering by the wind to the N. N. E. - sunset down M. topsail & came to "fish" it, if being shoring. M. & latter parts moderate breeze from do. Daylight made sail. - Steered E. N. E. saw a bark going S. 800 strokes. Lat Obs. 49° 15'
Long Obs. 66° 35'

Wednesday

July 23rd First part of this day moderate breeze from N. W. & pleasant - steering after 3 P.M. N. by E. - sunset about M. topsail & came to the sail. M. & latter parts fresh breeze from N. W. with passing squalls. Daylight made sail & steered N. by E. took out for hatching to get out the drift. 800 strokes. Lat Obs. 48° 25'

Thursday

July 24th First part fresh gale from N. W. double reefed the topsails & made all sail & steered N. by E. (P.M. took in topsail & close reefed M. topsail & came to the wind. M. & latter parts a hard gale from do. took in M. topsail & close reefed the mainsail.
for strokes. Lat Obs. 45° 59'
Long Obs. 56° 13'
