Observations on Board Bark & Ship

Friday
March 4th 1859. Came in with strong wind
from S. W. & clear - steering to the N.
Under two double tided topsails till
6 P.M. then came to the wind under
a close reefed M. & M. sail.
M. & Latter parts moderate breeze from
S. E. daylight made sail & steered to
the E. saw nothing - employed in
repairing studding sails. - 100 strokes
Lat 41° 09'

Saturday First part light wind from S.
5th Course S. by E. 6 P.M. saw a sail
ahead - J. do. shortened sail.
M. & Latter parts moderate breeze from
S. E. daylight made sail & steered
by the wind to the S. E. passed a
paddle & some pieces of a steam boat
saw Killers & Sun-fish - Lat 41° 01'
100 strokes. Long 52° 25'
Repaired studding sails.

Sunday First part fresh breeze from S. by E.
6th & cloudy - steering as above - double
top of the topsails - saw a sail going
S. E. 6 P.M. raining & a little thunder
& lightning furled the courses, jib
& spanker. M. & Latter parts fresh
breeze from S. by E. to N. & started the
line sailing - steering by the wind to
the N. E.
100 strokes. Lat 42°

Sunday
March 5th 1859. First part of this day moderate
breeze from S. by E. & overcast lowering
weather steering to the N. E. under easy sail
7 P.M. took in jib & spanker & went to the
N. E. Evening, thunder. M. & Latter parts
moderate breeze from S. E. daylight
made sail & steered S. by E. by the
out after hold & tinned decks to separate
mattress. Pumped 800 strokes.
Lat 42° 21'

Monday First part moderate breeze from S. E.
8th Course S. by E. by the sunset shortened sail
& came to the wind to the E. saw
porpoises. - 13 minutes a little down which
is unaccountable. M. & Latter parts light
air & calm - very pleasant weather.
saw Grampus. 100 strokes out water before
the 10th of the 100 strokes.
Lat 42° 00'

Tuesday First part light air from N. E. & calm.
9th Sent down for to span and yard to fish
it, it being spring M. & Latter parts
light wind from N. E. & pleasant -
made sail at daylight & steered to the
wind to the E. repairing yard, setting
up jibs, making spun yarn &c.
100 strokes
Lat 43° 57'
Long 51° 00'
