Sunday Jan 18th 1857
Paper with good weather and moderate
winds from S.E.W heading West so ends
Lat by Ob 56.29 South Long 61.16 West

Monday Jan 19th 1857
Paper with light winds from S.W
steering W.S.W later part heading
South so ends then 24 hours
Lat by Ob 57.05 South Long 62.10 West

Tuesday Jan 20th
comes in with moderate winds from
S.W heading S.E.W at 3 P.M. tacked
ship heading W.N.W mile and
later part strong winds from W.S.W
heading S.W so ends
Lat by Ob 56.57 S, Long 65.27 West

Wednesday Jan 21th
Commences with strong winds
from W.N.W and squally heading
S.W mile part calm later part
light winds from South steering W.S.W
Lat by Ob 57.01 South Long 65.57 West

Thursday Jan 22th 1857
Commences with good weather and
light winds from South steering W.S.W
mile part calm later part strong winds
from W.S.W heading N.W at 5 A.M.
passed Cape Horn bearing N.N.W dist 40 miles
Lat by Ob 57.18 South Long 67.00 West



Williams Master bound on a whaling voyage

Friday Jan 23th 1857
Commences with good weather and strong
winds from W.S.W heading South
under double reefed top sails one ship
in sight to windward Cape Horn in sight
A Steam dist 25 miles mid and later part
strong winds and rainy so ends

Saturday Jan 24th 1857
Comes in with strong winds from
West and rainy heading S.E.W one
ship in company mile and later
part strong winds from W.S.W heading
N.W so ends then 24 hours
Lat by Ob 57.29 South Long 69.34 W

Sunday Jan 25th
Comes in with strong winds from
W.S.W and squally heading N.W
in company with A bark ship
mile and later part the same so ends
Lat by Ob 56.25 South Long by Obs 71.15 W

Monday Jan 26th 1857
Commences with good weather and
moderate winds from S.E.W heading
West carrying all sail saw one ship
bound East at 7 P.M. wore ship heading
South mile and later part the same
Lat by Ob 56.21 S Long 71.19 West

Tuesday Jan 27th
Paper with strong gales from
S.E.W heading West carried short
sail later part strong gails from
West heading S.E.W so ends
