Calm with good weather and light
winds from East steering N.W. by S. ends

Sunday April 5th 1857
Calm with good weather and light
winds from East steering N.W. by S. ends
Lat by Obs 20.29 North

Monday April 6th 1857
Calm with good weather and light
winds from East steering N.W. by S. ends
Lat by Obs 20.30 North Long 143.00 West

Tuesday April 7th 1857
Calm with good weather and light
winds from East steering N.W. by S. ends

A head at 10 raised the island of Mowee
bearing West dist 50 miles ~~ends~~
Lat by Obs 20.35 North Long by Chron 144.40

Saturday April 11th 1857
Calm with good weather and light
winds from East steering N.W. by S.
the island of Mowee in sight bearing
N.W. by South dist 55 miles at 5 P.M.
hove to heading off shore at 9 P.M.
cep the ship off N.W. by S. ends

Sunday April 12th 1857
Calm with good weather and calm
at 5 P.M. came to anchor at the
island of Mowee in 12 fath of water
in company with 3 ships made
part the same later part sent a
raft of casks on shore for water
at ends

Monday April 13th 1857
Ship at anchor at Mowee all hands
busy at 6 P.M. commenced smoking
ship to kill rats later part rang coxswain
and raft of water on board to ends

Tuesday April 14th 1857
Calm with rainy weather men
employed in showing water later part
the same on watch on shore on liberty
to ends
