

Remarks on Board Ship Cincinnati

Monday April 27th 1857
comes in with good weather and light
winds from E.N.E. heading N. by W.
men employed in ship's duty middle
and later part calm men employed
in mending sails to ends
Lat by Obs 29.30 North

Tuesday April 28th
comes in with good weather and
calm men employed in mending
sails middle and later part light
winds from E.N.E. heading East
to ends Lat by Obs 29.50 North

Wednesday April 29th
comes in with good weather and
light winds from E.N.E. heading
East at 6 P.M. tacked ship back N.W.
middle and later part the same to ends
Lat by Obs 30.10 North

Thursday April 30th
comes in with good weather and light
winds from E.N.E. heading N. by W.
middle and later part the same
Lat by Obs 32.00 North

Friday May 1st 1857
comes in with good weather
and light winds from East heading
N.N.E. men employed in coopersing
head middle and later part the same
Lat by Obs 32.41 North

of Stringtown Williams Master

Saturday May 2nd 1857
comes in with good weather and
light airs from South heading North
middle part calm later part fresh
winds from N.E. heading N.E. to ends
Lat by Obs 33.25 North

Sunday May 3rd
comes in with good weather and
fresh winds from E.S.E. heading
N. by W. middle and later part much
the same to ends then 24 hours
Lat by Obs 35.56 North Long 160.10 West

Monday May 4th
comes in with good weather and strong
winds from E.N.E. coars N.N.E. evening
hol top sails at 6 P.M. took reefed the
top sails and took in the main sail
later part more moderate to ends
Lat by Obs 36.09 North

Tuesday May 5th
comes in with good weather and
strong winds from E.N.E. heading N.N.E.
middle part much the same later
part strong winds and rain to ends
Lat by Obs 40.41 North

Wednesday May 6th
comes in with strong winds from
E.N.E. and rainy steering N.N.E.
middle and later part much the
same to ends No obs
