Ship leaking 100 strokes per hour

Lat by Obs 38.29 South Long 103.10 W

Saturday Sep the 19
Comes in with strong winds from
S.E. & and some what squally head
South under short sail ship
leaking the same midle and later
part light winds so ends No Obs

Sunday Sep the 20
Comes in with good weather
and calm midle part the same
later part light winds from S.E.
so ends men employe in mending
the fore top sail No Obs

Monday Sep the 21
Comes in with good weather and
fresh winds from S.E. heading
S.E. & midle and later part strong
gales from North so ends
No Obs

Tuesday Sep the 22 1857
Comes in with strong gales from
North East and rainy heading S.E. &
under short reefed main top sail
midle and later part calmer moderate
so ends Lat by Obs 41.00 South
Ship leaks 100 strokes per hour

Wednesday Sep the 23
Comes in with light winds from
N.E. and rain squalls heading
S.E. & ship leaks 140 strokes per
hour midle and later part right
winds from S.E. & heading East
Lat by Obs 41.27 South Long 101.00 W

Thursday Sep the 24
Comes in with good weather and
fresh winds from S.W. coars East
Ship leaks 100 strokes per hour midle
and later part much the same
so ends Lat 42.26 South Long 97.20 W

Friday Sep the 25
Comes in with strong winds from
N.E. & squally coars East
Ship leaks 100 strokes per hour midle
and later part the same so ends
Lat by Obs 42.01 S. Long 94.27 W

Saturday Sep the 26
Comes in with good weather and
light winds from N.E. & coars
East ship leaks 100 strokes per
hour midle and later part much
the same so ends No Obs
