Sunday Sep the 27
Comes in with light winds from
N.W. and runs coast East
Ship leaks the same mile and
later part light winds from West
Lat by Ob 44.26 S Long 59.09 W

Monday Sep the 28 1857
Comes in with good weather and
light winds from S.W. coasts E by N
Ship leaks the same mile part
the same later part strong
gales and hail squalls to end
Lat by Ob 44.37 S Long 54.09 W

Tuesday Sep the 29
Comes in with strong gales
from S.W. with hail squalls
steering E.N.E. ship making
120 strokes per hour at 2 P.M.
have tow on the Starboard tack
heading S.E. mile and later part
moderate at 9 A.M. stand
of E.N.E. so ends there 24 hours
Lat by Ob 44.26 S Long 52.17 W

Wednesday Sep the 30
Comes in with strong winds
from S.W. steering E.N.E.
Ship leaks 120 strokes per hour
mile and later part light
winds from W.S.W. so ends
Lat by Ob 44.14 S Long 50.15 W

Thursday October the 1 1857
Comes in with good weather and light
winds from W.S.W. steering E.N.E.
Ship leaks 120 strokes per hour mile
and later part the same so ends
Lat by Ob 43.55 S Long 75.15 West

Friday Oct the 2
Comes in with good weather and light
winds from S.W. steering E.N.E.
Ship leaks the same mile and later
part the same so ends there 24 hours
Lat by Ob 43.42 S Long 77.15 West

Saturday Oct the 3
Comes in with good weather and
light winds from W.S.W. steering
E.N.E. ship leaks 120 strokes per
hour mile and later part strong
winds from S.W. at 10 A.M. raised
the Island of Guafu bearing East
dist 50 miles at 12 noon ship so ends
Lat by Ob 43.19 South Long 75.45 West

Sunday Oct the 4
Comes in with strong winds from
S.W. heading W.S.W. under double
reefed top sails ship leaks the same
mile part the same later part strong
winds from West heading S.S.W. so ends
Lat by Ob 44.09 S Long 76.27 West
