Saturday Oct the 31 /57
Paper with good weather men
employed in getting wood and clearing
ship and so forth Capt and boats
crew on shore at 10 P.M. bark
N.G. Perkins arrived capt Collins
60 Hb. whale so ends

Sunday Nov 1st
Paper with good weather all
hands with the exceptions of shore
and on liberty so ends

Monday Nov 2nd
Paper with good weather and
light winds all hands on board
excepting 9 or 10 deserters. Parry
Mullane Christie Howland
Charles Stewart William Smith
Jas A. Wolcott John Black James Lackey
A. K. Burgh, A. Curran men employed in taking
wood on board and so forth

Tuesday Nov 3rd
Paper with good weather men
employed in putting ship and
taking wood on board and so forth

Wednesday Nov 4th
Comes in with good weather men
employed in storing wood and water
we have not had from the deserters
one boat crew on shore later
part rainy at 6 P.M. two of the
deserters returned on board by the
man William Smith and
John Black on duty so ends

at St Carlos

Thursday Nov the 5 /57
Comes in with good weather
and strong winds all hands
on board except 7 deserters they
have been gone 4 days had
nothing from them later part
rainy so ends

Friday Nov the 6
Comes in with strong winds
all hands on board except the
7 deserters middle and later part
rainy so ends

Saturday Nov the 7
Comes in with heavy weather
middle and later part the same
so ends

Sunday Nov the 8
Comes in with strong winds and
rainy weather one watch on
liberty so ends

Monday Nov the 9
Comes in with rainy weather
one watch on shore on liberty
middle and later part the same

Tuesday Nov the 10
Paper with heavy weather
one watch on liberty the rest
employed in getting wood and water

Wednesday Nov 11
Paper with good weather one watch
on liberty so ends
