W.N.W. and squally heading
S.W. at 3 P.M. double reefed the
top sails mild and later part
strong gales at 10 P.M. wear
ship heading N.E. W under
short sail so ends Lat 41.52 S

Friday Nov the 20
Comes in with strong winds from
W.S.W. and squally heading N.W.
under close reefed top sails and
coarser mild and later part good
weather and moderate winds from
S.W. steering N.W. so ends
Lat by Ob 39.45 South

Saturday Nov the 21
Comes in with good weather and
light winds from S.W. steering
N.E. W mild and later part
the same so ends Lat 37.20 South

Sunday Nov the 22
Paper with good weather and
light winds from S.W. steering
N.E. one ship in sight
Lat by Ob 36.17 South
