and fresh breezes from S.E. heading
S.W. saw black fish and got 2
middle and later part the same
men employed in boiling black
fish so ends Lat 00.25 North

Friday Jan the 1 1858
Comes in with good weather
and fresh winds from S.E. heading
S.W. by W. later part
the same so ends
Lat by Obs 00.07 North Long 177.20 W

Saturday Jan the 2
Comes in with good weather
and light winds from S.E. heading
S.W. men employed in
mending sails ship leaks the
same middle and later part
the same so ends Lat 00.00

Sunday Jan the 3
Paper with good weather and
calm Lat 00.01 South

Monday Jan the 4 1858
Paper with good weather and
light winds from S.E. heading
West men employed in repairing
the four top sail ship leaks the
same Lat by Obs 00.12 North Long 100.51 W

Tuesday Jan the 5
Paper with light winds from
South heading N.W. by S. ship
leaks the same Lat 00.03 South

Wednesday Jan the 6
Paper with light winds from
S.W. heading S.W. by S.
Lat 1.00 South

Thursday Jan the 7
Paper with light winds from
S.E. heading S.W. men employed
in coopering head Lat by Obs 2.40 S

Friday Jan the 8
Paper with light winds from S.E.
heading S.W. by S. men employed in
coopering meat ship leaks the same
Lat by Obs 3.40 South Long 106.00 W

Saturday Jan the 9
Paper with light winds from
S.E. heading S.W. saw a gam
of sperm whales going quick
to windward Lat 5.00 S Long 107.57

Sunday Jan the 10
Paper with light winds from S.E.
heading South Lat 6.41 S Long 108.12 W
