Tuesday Feb the 2
Paper with good weather and light
winds from East steering West
Lat by Obs 20.25 N, Long 154.00 W

Wednesday Feb the 3
Paper with good weather and light
winds from E. by S steering N.W. by N
at 6 P.M. raised the Island of Owhyhee
bearing S.W. dist 45 miles so ends

Thursday Feb the 4
Paper with light winds from North
heading N.W. by N at 1 P.M. raised
the East end of Moorea bearing N.W. by N
dist 25 miles later part light winds
so ends there 24 hours

Friday Feb the 5
Comes in with light airs from
North heading West bound in to
the passage between Morotoi and Moorea
at 5 P.M. came to anchor of the base
of Lakena in 14 fath of water later
part good weather so ends

Saturday Feb the 6
Paper with good weather laying
of the town of Lakena in company
with 4 other ships
