Sunday Feb the 7 - 1858
Paper with good weather all hands
on board

Monday Feb the 8
comes in with good weather men
employed in getting of water and
taking on board potatoes later
part the same so ends

Tuesday Feb the 9
Paper with good weather men
employed in stowing water and soap

Wednesday Feb the 10
Paper with good weather and light
winds men employed in stowing
water etc ends

Thursday Feb the 11
Paper with good weather men
employed in mending the fore top
sail and fore top gallant sail

Friday Feb the 12
Paper with good weather and calm
one watch on shore on liberty

Saturday Feb the 13
Paper with good weather one watch
on liberty

Sunday Feb the 14
Paper with good weather all
hands on board

At Moore Sandwich Islands

Monday Feb the 15
Paper with good weather one
watch on liberty so ends

Tuesday Feb the 16
Paper with good weather and
strong winds from S.E. one watch
on liberty later part strong
winds and rain at 10 A.M. drop
the account and the so ends

Wednesday Feb the 17
Paper with moderate winds from
South East all hands on board

Thursday Feb the 18
Paper with good weather and light
winds from S.E. all hands on board
waiting for a fair wind to go to sea

Friday Feb the 19
Paper with good weather and moderate
winds from S.E. capt and one boats
crew on shore at 6 P.M. all hands
on board later part the same so ends

Saturday Feb the 20
comes in with light winds from
S.E. ship all ready for sea but
waiting for a fair wind later
part strong gales from S.E. and
squally and heavy rain so ends

Sunday Feb the 21
comes in with strong winds and squalls
from S.E. later part good weather
at 8 A.M. took the anchor board to weighing
so ends
