

Ship Cincinnati F Williams

Monday Feb th 22 1858
Comes in with good weather and moderate winds from South steering N. by W bound to Waikoo at 6 P.M. Shorten sail at 12 noon ship head S. by E at 4 A.M. wear back the wind being so much South cold not fetch Waikoo tack and tack between Simon hill and Morotoi in company with A bark and brig.

Tuesday Feb th 23
Comes in with strong winds from South ship laying back and tack between Simon hill and Morotoi mile and later part the same so ends

Wednesday Feb th 24
Paper with good weather and strong winds from S. by W heading West Simon hill bearing N. by W dist 12 miles so ends

Thursday Feb th 25
Paper with strong winds with rain gusts from S. W Simon hill bearing N. by W dist 14 miles at 4 A.M. strong winds from S. W steering N. by W for Simon hill so ends

Friday Feb th 26
Comes in with light winds from N. N. W steering N. by W Simon hill A head dist 12 miles at 5 P.M. wear ship head N. by E at 5 A.M. stand for Simon hill at 7 noon ship

Master at the Sandwich Islands

Saturday Feb th 27 1858
Comes in with good weather and light winds from North ship laying off and on at the point of Honolulu the capt and one boats crew on shore at 4 P.M. Capt Williams and boats crew returned on board squared the yards and steered S. W bound to the Locholash sea later part the same steering N. by E so ends

Sunday Feb th 28
Comes in with good weather and light winds from S. by E steering N. by E mile and later part the same so ends Lat by Obs 20.31 North

Monday March th 1 1858
Comes in with good weather and light winds from South steering N. by E mile and later part the same Lat by Obs 20.13 N

Tuesday March th 2
Paper with good weather and light winds from South steering West so ends Lat by Obs 19.57 N

Wednesday Mar th 3
Paper with strong winds from North and rainy steering West so ends Lat by Obs 19.48 N
