Monday Mar the 29
Comes in with strong gales with
hail squalls from N.E.W. heading
N.W. under short sail midle part
more moderate at 6 A.M. on bent
the four top sail and bent. At nother
these 24 hours ends with strong gales
and hail and rain squalls from S.W.
Lat by Obs 40.00 N. Long 164.20 E

Tuesday Mar the 30
Comes in with strong gales and
squalls from S.W. heading N.E.W.
at 6 P.M. better weather and less
wind heading North at 7. wear ship
heading S.W. at 2 A.M. wear ship
head N.E.W. bent. A new mizzen
top sail and A new main spencer
so ends Lat 40.26 N. Long 162.00 E

Wednesday Mar the 31
Comes in with strong winds from S.W.
steering N.E. or midle part strong
gales and rain squalls from S.W.
midle and later part the same winds

and later part the same so ends No Obs

Friday April the 2
Comes in with strong gales from
West heading N.E.W. midle and later
part good weather and light winds from
S.E.W. steering West one ship in
sight so ends No Obs

Saturday Apr the 3
Comes in with good weather and moderate
winds from N.E.W. heading West midle
and later part strong winds from
N.E.W. heading S.W. so ends ~~these~~
Lat by Obs 40.44 N Long 162.10 West

Sunday April the 4
Comes in with good weather and strong
winds from N.E.W. heading S.W.
at 6 P.M. wear ship head North
midle and later part midle the
so ends Lat 40.50 N Long 161.00 E

Monday Apr the 5
Comes in with strong winds and snow
squalls from West heading N.E.W.
later part strong winds from S.W. head
N.E.W. so ends Lat by Obs 42.21 North

Tuesday April the 6
Paper with light winds from S.E.
steering N.W. so ends Lat 39.47 N
