Monday April the 19 1858
Comes in with light winds from S.E. and smoky weather N.W. bound in threw the Skates in tow the ocholash sea threw the north passage but one in company with Ship Sharon of Fair Haven Capt King the passage is in Lat 49.12 North later part thick weather Stearing N.W.

Tuesday Apr the 20
Comes in with light winds from N.E. and thick weather Stearing N.W. midle and later part the same so ends Lat 52.13 N Long 150.45 E

Wednesday April 21st
Comes in with strong winds from N.E. and foggy heading N.W. midle and later part calm and thick weather so ends No Ob

Thursday Apr the 22
Comes in with thick weather and calm midle and later part light winds from South at 4 P.M. raised A patch of small ice so ends Lat by 66 53.03 North

Ochotash Sea Bound North

Friday April the 23 1858
Comes in with light winds from South Stearing North at 2 P.M. A thick snow storm at 8 have tow on the back tack with the head yards at back later part good weather and light winds from N.W. heading N.E. saw A plenty of ice Lat 53.59 N Long 151.00 E

Saturday Apr the 24
Comes in with good weather and light winds from N.W. Stearing N.E. one ship in sight A Stearing Stearing the same and ice in sight midle and later part strong winds and A grate quantity of Ice trying to get north at 4 A.M. Ship Sharon Lat 54.25 North Long 152.20 East

Sunday April the 25
Comes in with good weather and strong winds from N.W. and any quantity of Ice in sight trying to work north in company with Ship Sharon Ice thick and heavy later part thick weather so ends No Ob

Monday Apr the 26
Comes in with thick weather and calm later part light winds from S.E. coast North so ends Lat 55.20 N Long 152.20 E

Tuesday April the 27
Comes in with good weather and light winds from S.E. Stearing North at 4 P.M. raised ice A head at 5 spoke Ship Sharon later part strong gales and thick weather so ends Lat 66
