

Saturday May 8th 1858
Comes in with good weather
and strong winds from E. S. E.
Clearing N. E. W. in company
with 5 or 6 Ships land in sight
Cape Olvin bearing N. W. dist
45 miles at 9 P. M. came low
ice and wear ship heading S. E.
middle and later part the same
So ends 45 00

Sunday May 9th
Paper with light winds and thick
weather So ends 45 00

Monday May 10th
Comes in with good weather and
light winds from East steering
W. S. W. in company with 4
other Ships land in sight Cape
Olvin bearing N. E. W. dist 40 miles
later part strong gales from
E. S. E. and thick weather heading
South So ends 45 00

Tuesday May 11th
Comes in with thick weather
and strong gales from East
steering by the wind under short
sail later part good weather
and light winds from North
heading E. S. E. So ends 45 00

Wednesday May 12th
Comes in with light winds from
North and a thick snow storm
heading E. S. E. later part good weather
So ends 45 00

Thursday May 13th
Comes in with good weather and light
winds from West Cape Olvin in sight
bearing North dist 20 miles later part
the same So ends

Friday May 14th
Comes in with good weather and light
winds from West Cape Olvin bearing
N. E. W. dist 20 miles seven Ships in
sight spoke ship rain clear clean
and ship very wide and later part
the same Lat 55.00 course

Saturday May 15th
Comes in with good weather and light
winds from East Cape Olvin bearing
N. E. W. dist 30 miles spoke ship
Massachusetts of Santucket nothing
later part the same So ends 45 00

Sunday May 16th
Comes in with good weather and
light air from E. S. E. Cape Olvin
bearing N. E. W. dist 30 miles
middle and later part calm So ends

Monday May 17th
Comes in with good weather and calm
ice and ships plenty but now whales
later part light winds from N. E. W.
heading North So ends 45 00

Tuesday May 18th
Paper with light winds from
W. S. W. Cape Olvin bearing
North dist 30 miles. So ends
