

Saturday May th 29 — 1858
Comes in with good weather and light
winds at 10 AM came to anchor
in big bay to the east of Jefferys
point in company with bark
Massachusetts of N. Bedford capt
Green so ends

Sunday May th 30
comes in with good weather and light
winds from West ship lying at anchor
in the east part of big bay under
the south shore at 11 AM the
ice came down on us and had
to get under way and stand at
anchor the bay and anchor under
the south shore so ends

Monday May th 31
Comes in with good weather
and light winds ship lying at
anchor in big bay later part
the same plenty of ice in the
bay yet and now whales

Tuesday June th 1. 1858
Comes in with good weather and
light winds from W. S. W. ship
at anchor in big bay in company
with bark Massachusetts of
New Bedford later part the same

Wednesday June th 2
Comes in with good weather and
strong winds from W. S. W. ship
at anchor in big bay east part
later part the same so ends

Thursday June th 3
Comes in with good weather and
light winds from E. S. E. ship lying
at anchor in the east part of big
bay in company with 3 other ships
later part the same say 3 bowheads
and chert so ends

Friday June th 4
Comes in with good weather and light
winds cruising for whales in the east
part of big bay later part the same

Saturday June th 5
Comes in with good weather and
light winds cruising in big bay
in company with ship Liza
Adams and bark Massachusetts
of N. Bedford at 8 PM calm the
ice closed in on us on all sides
at 10 came to anchor in the ice
the ice became heavy and a strong
current it ground hard later
part the same so ends

Sunday June th 6
Comes in with light air and
thick weather ship at anchor in
the east end of big bay in the ice
ice heavy strong westerly current
the ice rubs the ship hard at 11
P.M. took the anchor and let the
ship drift with the ice so ends
