

Monday June the 7 1858
Comes in with thick weather
and calm at 1 P.M. the fog let
up and we found our selves
near Bowhead island in the ice
at 3 P.M. light winds from West
clearing S.W. through the ice
at 10 came tow anchor clear of
ice at 11 took the anchor & gain
on the A count of ice later part
calm and plenty of ice so ends

Tuesday June the 8
Comes in with light winds and
clear weather steering through
the ice at 5 P.M. came tow anchor
under the North shore cape
Jefferys bearing South middle and
later part thick fog and calm

Wednesday June the 9
Comes in with light airs from
West at 1 P.M. took the anchor
and stood in shore at 6 came
tow anchor in 7 fathoms of water
middle and later part the same

Thursday June the 10
Comes in with good weather
and light winds from S.W. 2 boats
in shore at 4 P.M. came on board
middle and later part the same

Friday June the 11
Comes in with thick weather ship
at anchor in big bay of town
middle and later part the same

Saturday June the 12
Comes in with good weather ship at
anchor in big bay of town
3 boats in shore cruising for whales
at 7 P.M. boats returned on board saw
now whales later part thick weather
so ends

Sunday June the 13
Comes in with thick weather and
light winds from South ship at anchor
in big bay middle and later part
the same so ends

Monday June the 14
Comes in with good weather
and light winds from South
at 1 P.M. took the anchor at
3 in Reed & gain so ends

Tuesday June the 15
Comes in with good weather
ship at anchor in big bay 2 boats
in shore cruising for whales middle
and later part the same so ends

Wednesday June the 16
Comes in with good weather and
light winds ship at anchor in big
bay 4 boats in shore cruising for
whales now whales but A plenty
of ships later part the same

Thursday June the 17
Comes in with good weather and
light winds from West men employed in
getting A raft of water from the shore
at 3 P.M. took the anchor toward West
later part the same so ends
