

July 1st 1858
Comes in with thick weather
and light winds from S.W. Steady
S.W. W. middle and later part
the same so ends No Ob

Tuesday July 2nd
Comes in with light winds from
N.E. heading W. S. W. thick weather
at 2 P.M. lit up saw the
land at 6 came tow anchor in
30 fathoms of water of same
harbor later part good weather
boats in shore cruising so ends

Wednesday July 3rd
Comes in with strong winds
from N.E. and thick weather
ship at anchor of same harbor
later part light winds and good
weather at 6 A.M. took the anchor
and steered S.W. so ends

Thursday July 4th
Comes in with good weather
and calm at 3 P.M. came
tow anchor 30 miles S.W. of
same later part light winds
at 4 P.M. hove up the anchor and
steered S.W. A long shore bound
tow the S.W. bay so ends

Friday July 5th
Comes in with light airs from
E. S. E. heading S.W. at 1 P.M. calm
came tow anchor in 27 fathoms of water
at 6 A.M. took the anchor and steered S.W.
A long shore bound so ends

Saturday July 6th
Comes in with light winds from
S.W. Steady S.W. at long the land
at 9 P.M. came tow anchor of Rocky
point in company with 5 other
ships at 6 A.M. took the anchor and
steered S.W. at 10 calm and thick came
tow anchor at again so ends

Sunday July 7th
Comes in with thick and rainy
weather ship at anchor about
10 miles S.W. of rocky point in
company with 4 bark name own
none middle and later part the
same so ends these 24 hours

Monday July 8th
Comes in with thick weather and
light easterly winds ship at anchor
in the S.W. bay saw 4 number of
ships but none whales later part
the same so ends

Tuesday July 9th
Comes in with strong winds from
East and rainy ship at anchor
in S.W. bay in 20 fathoms of water
middle and later part the same so ends

Wednesday July 10th
Comes in with strong winds from
the East. N. East and rainy ship
at anchor about midway of S.W.
bay saw 2 ships under way
middle and later part the same
so ends
