Tuesday July th 13
Ship at anchor in the S.W. bay
light airs from N.E. and thick
weather later part the same

Wednesday July th 14
Comes in with light winds from
N.E. and thick fog later part
the same so ends

Thursday July th 15
Paper with light winds from
N.E. ship at anchor in the S.W.
bay boats cruising for whales
later part the same so ends

Thursday July th 16
Paper with light winds and
thick weather at 1 P.M. took
11 casks on shore and filled them
with water and left them and
brought of wood so ends

Friday July th 17
Ship at anchor in the S.W. bay
boats cruising for whales saw
5 or 6 later part thick weather
weather lowered of draft of water
so ends

Saturday July th 18
Ship at anchor in the S.W. bay
light winds from East thick and
rainy middle and later part the
same so ends

Sunday July th 19
Paper with thick weather and calm
boats in shore cruising for whales
so ends

Monday July th 20
Paper with thick weather boats
in shore cruising for whales saw
3 or 4 could not strike them

Tuesday July th 21
Paper with light winds and thick
weather boats in shore A whaling
struck one and took him A long
long side so ends

Wednesday July th 22
Ship at anchor in the S.W. bay
boats cruising for whales saw
A few so ends

Thursday July th 23
Ship at anchor in S.W. bay boats
of whaling struck one and took
him A long side and cut him in

Friday July th 24
Paper with good weather saw
now whales so ends

Saturday July th 25
Paper with thick weather saw now
whales so ends
