eagle point so ends

Saturday Oct. 4
Comes in with strong winds
from N.E. later part the
same so ends

Sunday Oct. 5
Comes in with strong winds
from West at 8 A.M. took
the anchor board out later
part light winds so ends

Ship Cincinnati

Monday Oct. the 6
Paper with light winds from
N.E.

Tuesday Oct. the 7
Comes in with good weather
and light winds from N.E.
saw 4 number of whales
board struck one and took
him A long side and cut
him in 30 ends

Wednesday Oct. the 8
Paper with load weather and
men employed in bogging so ends

Thursday Oct. the 9
Paper with light westerly
winds saw whales board
struck 2 and they took
the lines so ends

Friday Oct. the 10
Paper with light winds from
N.E. saw whales and
chart so ends

Saturday Oct. the 11
Strong winds from N.E. men
employed in stowing down
oil so ends

Sunday Oct. the 12
Paper with strong winds
from N.E. and ran the
North end of big Hunter bay
E. & E. so ends
