

Remarks On Board

Monday Oct the 12
Paper with strong winds
from N.E. steering by the
wind tack and tack later
part the same so ends

Tuesday Oct the 13
Comes in with strong winds
from N.E. with rain steering
by the wind tack and tack
under cable reefed top sails
and courses when they will
stand later part the same

Wednesday Oct the 14
Paper with strong winds
from N.E. and rain curing
short sail by the wind

Thursday Oct the 15
Comes in with strong gales
from N.E. and rain heading
E.S.E. under short sail
at 7 A.M. raised round island
N.E. of big chanter and
squared the yards for it
steering South at 11 A.M.
let go the big anchor under
the lee of this island in
smooth water in 19 fath
and payed out 90 fath of
chain and stopped down
cent A new main top sail
and so forth so ends

Ship Cincinnati

Friday Oct the 16 1858
Paper with strong gales from
N.E. ship lying at anchor and
round island the island bearing
N.N.E. later part A thick
snow storm so ends

Saturday Oct the 17
Paper with strong gales
and A thick snow storm
from N.E. ship at anchor
under round island in 19
fath of water big anchor down
and 90 fath of chain out

Sunday Oct the 18
Comes in with strong gales from
N.E. later part snow moderate

Monday Oct the 19
Comes in with strong N.E. winds
middle part calm later part
light winds from West at 5 A.M.
took the anchor steard E.S.E. &
ships in sight so ends

Tuesday Oct the 20
Comes in with light airs from
West steering E. N.E. & ships
in sight at head middle part calm
later part the same so ends
Lat by Obs 55. 25 North

Wednesday Oct the 21
Paper with light winds from
North steering E.S.E. so ends
