

Remarks On Board Ship

Thursday Oct 22 1858
Comes in with strong winds from
N.N.E. with much squalls heading
East one bark in sight steering
the same middle and later part
light winds from N.N.E. so ends
Lat by Obs 55.04 N

Friday Oct 23
Comes in with light winds from
S.E. steering S.S.E. middle and
later part strong winds from
S.E. heading South so ends
Lat by Obs 54.34 N

Saturday Oct 24
Comes in with strong winds
from East heading N.N.E. at 5
P.M. lashed ship head S.E.
middle and later part strong
gales from N.N.E. heading East
so ends

Sunday Oct 25
Comes in with strong gales
from N.N.E. heading East
under A. C. B. reefed main
top sail middle and later part
more moderate at 4 A.M. steered
of S.E. so ends Lat by Obs 53.25 N

Monday Oct 26
Comes in with strong winds
from North steering S.E.
middle and later part the same
Lat by Obs 51.08 N Long 157.00 E

Tuesday Oct 27
Comes in with good weather and
strong winds from N.N.W. steering
S.S.E. middle and later part light
winds from S.E. heading S.E. so ends
Lat by Obs 50.03 N

Wednesday Oct 28
Comes in with light winds from
South heading S.S.E. middle and
later part the same heading S.S.E.
Lat 49.46 N

Thursday Oct 29
Comes in with light winds from
South steering S.S.E. by the
wind at 1 P.M. raised the land
baring East by South dist 40 miles
at 15 noon ship head of shore
middle and later part light winds
from S.E. ship laying off and on

Friday Oct 30
Comes in with strong winds from
S.E. middle and later part middle
the same so ends

Saturday Oct 31
Comes in with light winds from
West steering S.E. the 50 passage
at 6 P.M. past threw betwixt
Onagkutan and parmaschuan
islands with A strong breeze from
N.N.W. steering S.S.E. later part
light airs from South so ends
Lat by Obs 49.06 North
