First part Lite Winds from North
East Steam tug towed us out of Home
at 1 P. M. bound to the Ochotash Sea
Course South West Middle and latter
part more Wind course West So end this day

Sunday Feb 27
First part no Wind and Cloudy
Course West Middle and latter part
Strong Breezes from North East Laying off
and on at Atter So Ends this day

Monday Feb 28
Passes With good Weather Wind North
East Laying off and on at Atter
getting hogs and vegetables So ends the

Tuesday March 1, 1859
Passes With good Weather and Strong
Breeze Laying off and on at Atter Capt
Williams and 2 boats crew in trading for
hogs and vegetables at 3 P. M. Capt Williams
and crew came on board squared yards bound for
Ochotash Sea Course South West So ends this day

Wednesday March 2
Good Weather all this day Wind
North East First part Course West by
South latter part W. by N. Lat 21.50
North saw a ship steering the same
as we are so ends this day

Thursday March 3
Passes With good Weather Wind North
East Course W. by S. the same Ship
in site to day Lat 20.40 Long 155.20

Friday March 4
Passes With good Weather and breeze
from North East Course West by South
Lat 20.40 N. Long 166.41 West Samming
With bark Adaline of New Bedford

Saturday March 5
Lite breeze from North East and
pleasant Course West S. West Lat 20.25

Sunday March 6
First part and Middle Lite Wind
from North East and pleasant latter
part Wind With rain Course W. by South
Lat 19.55 North Long 170.30 West
