W.S.W. no obs Nothing more than

First Part Strong Gales from W.S.W.
and pleasant Ship heading N.W.
under Closed Reef fore and Main
Top Sails, Miz in 6 A.M. kept her
off N.W. 11 A.M. Thick Weather Wind
the same Braced up heading W by N.
Mid the same latter part Moderate
Turn one reef out, top sails and set
Mizzen Wind W.S.W. heading N.W.W.
No obs So ends these 24 hours

Sunday April 3rd
First part Moderate Breezes from
W.S.W. Ship heading N.W. Mid
Wind halled to East Steering N.W.
Latter Part Strong Gales from S.E. with
Snow laying to under Closed reef Main
Top sail and main Spencer So ends this

Monday April 4th 1859
First Part Strong Gales from North
with Snow laying to under Closed
reef Main Spencer 6 A.M. Wind
halled to N.W. fore Ship heading
N.W. by N Mid calm latter part
Lite breezes from S.E. Course N.W.
No obs So ends these 24 hours

Tuesday April 5th
First part Strong Gales from W.S.W.
Ship heading S by E Mid Wind the
same under Closed reef top sails
fore Ship at 4 P.M. heading W.S.W.
Latter part the same Lat 48.00 North
Long 202.16 West So ends this day

Wednesday April 6th
Passes With Strong Gales from N.W.
heading W.S.W. 6 P.M. Wind halled
More to Westward fore Ship heading N
under Closed reef Top sail Mid and
Latter part Wind the same With some
squalls Lat 47.44 North no long

Thursday April 7th
First part Strong Gales from Westward
and Clear Mid the same fore Ship heading
N.W. latter part Wind halled to
Southward Course W.S.W. and Moderate
Lat 48.34 North Long 202.25 West

Friday April 8th
First part Lite Breezes from S.E. and
thick Snow Shorten a Sail heading off
shore Mid Wind halled to W.S.W. and
rainy latter part calm no obs So ends this
