

Ship Cincinnati Williams Master

Saturday April 9th 1859

First part calm and a big swell
running Mid Strong Gale from N
W heading S. W. Latter part Moderate
Breezes were pleasant weather Short Gales
heading S. W. Lat 49-03 North Long 203-37

Sunday April 10th

First part calm and clear Mid
lite Breezes from S. E. Steering N. W.
2 P. M. rapid the Land ahead
Latter part calm and Pleasant
Lat by obs 48-46 North Long 203-25 W.

Monday April 11th

First part lite Breezes from S. W. and
Pleasant Mid Strong Breezes from S. W.
heading N. W. under all sail 6 P. M.
Saw the land Latter part Wind hauled
West took in sail heading S. by W. and
Thick Mather Lat by obs 49-30 North Long 204

Tuesday April 12th

First part Lite Breezes from the
Northward and clear heading in for
the land all in site Mid Wind
from S. E. Thick fog Steering in through
the fog Passage Latter Wind hauled
to the North East and clear all sail
Got course N. W. 10 P. M. Saw the islands
a stern nothing more these 24 hours

Wednesday April 13th

First part fresh breezes from S. E.
and good weather Mid the same
2 Ships off sea quarter Steering the same
us course N. W. 7 P. M. Saw scattering

in Ochotash Sea 1859

Ice Shortened Gail heading off from the
ice Scatter part Strong Gale from East
Laying to under closed reef Main Topsail
and fore Stay Sail Lat by obs 51-20 North
Long 207-22 West Sea calm these 24 hours

Thursday April 14th 1859

Came in With heavy gales from East
and rainy weather Laying to under
closed reef Main topsail heading S.
Mid Moderate Set fore and Main Topsail
and got latter part calm and cloudy Saw
some small ice No obs

Friday April 15th

First part calm and clear ice
in site about 1 Mile off Turned reefs
out Topsails heading away from the ice
kept Driving until we got in to the ice
10 A. M. some ways in the ice Lite Breeze
from S. E. ice looks very scattering at
2 P. M. More Wind Dub reef Main
Topsails and blew up fore Latter part
N. W. good weather Drifting with the ice and
Dub reef Main Topsails ice in streaks
Lat by obs 52-17 North Long 208-58 West

Sat April 16th

Lite Breezes from East Steering S. E.
going out of the ice Started Copper range
bottle around bow Mid and latter
part Wind the same and good weather
4 P. M. all clear off the ice heading
N. by E Wind East Lat by obs 52-20 North
Long 208-56 West Nothing more seen
Worth mention these 24 hours
