Broked Copper on lower some in company
With 6 other Ships Mid Strong breeze from
N.W. and clear topped in late sail latter
part Strong Gale under closed reef tops
Sail lacking in clear weather lost by obs.
54-58 N. Long 205-42 West

See Tuesday April 26th 1854
Takes With Late Winds from N.E.
and Cloudy Ship under Dub reef
Laying off and around ice Looking
for Whales a heavy bed of ice to
the Northward 9 Ships in site Mid and
latter part Much the same Lay off
the Pack No ice to me's

See Wednesday April 27th
Comes in With Late Winds from N.E.
Laying on the ice 6 A.M. Turned reef out
tops Working along ice saw some Fin backs
and killers Mid very moderate 7 Ships
in site Land in site bearing E.N.E.
from us Latter part Strong Gale from
N.E. Lay off on the ice under closed
reef Top sails lost by obs 55-21 North
Long 206-00 West

See Thursday April 28th
Comes in With Clear Weather and Strong
Gale from Northward Laying with head
yards aback considerable ice about
6 A.M. braced up working up to
the ice 2 P.M. Blowed very hard
clewed fore and Main tops sail 3 P.M.
Moderated again Got fore and Main tops
closed reef Latter Strong Gale from North
Laying With head yards aback

Ship under Dub reef Laying off and on
the ice 6 A.M. Turned reef out and

Lat by obs 55-16 North Long 206-08 West

See Saturday April 30th
Comes in With Late Winds from N.E.
Laying with head yards aback at day light
Made Sail working to the Windward all
the can clear water as far and see from
from Mast head in the North West ice
to West and East off us Mid and latter time
the same and good weather Come to Scattering
ice Shorten Sail Laying off and on the ice
6 Ships in site Lat by obs 55-41 N Long 206-20

See Sunday May 1st 1854
Takes With Fine Weather Wind N.E.
First part Laying off and the ice Day
Late Made Sail Working to Northward all
the can ice in strips and good Deal
off clear water in the Northward at Dark
Shorten Sail Laying off and on in company
With 2 Ships Mid and Latter part the same
Lat by obs 55-32 Go ends this day

Monday May 2nd 1854
Begins With Late Breeze from N.W. Laying
very little off on the ice at Day Late clear water as
ice far as we can see from Mast head North
Made sail Strong by the wind to Northward
Mid More wind from W.N.W. heading off
to E.N.E. Come to the ice Dub reef Laying
off and on the ice Lat by obs 56-20 N Long 206
