

Thursday May 19/1859

Ice Comes in With Moderate breezes from North East and Thick fog 10 at. 11 sailing Stead in for the Saffrey point untill the ice made ice pulled off shore 3 Ships Went to the ice but all come out but one which more Wind from E. & L. and part Strong gale and Clear Day off and on the ice so end these 24

Friday May 20th 1859

Ice Comes With very Strong Gale from East Laying off and on between Bow head island and Saffrey Point Good in Within 15 Miles of land few little pieces off ice in situ 4 S. W. & S. E. roared few bumps off ice and halled aback the head yards Scatter part The same Laying aback so ends these

Saturday May 21st

Ice Comes in With strong gales and Clear Laying with head yards aback 3 at. 11 kept her N. W. run untill 4 at. 11 the ice and Left to heading off then under Short sail 9 at. 11 More Ship heading in Thru Looks very clear closed to Landed Bow head island Made Sail and working up latter with the same Wind East Shorten sail Laying off and Bow head island is 10 miles so ends these 24 hours

Sunday May 22nd 1859

Ice Comes With Little Breeze from E. S. E. and Thick fog first part Making 2. hour tacks Wind and latter part Steady Go Southward proceed up Thru With the top Gal on Sail set to ice these 24 hours so ends this day

Monday May 23rd

Ice Comes in With Little Winds from East and Thick fog first part Lay off and on at day like made all sail Steady to Southward trying to find the point of the ice so we can get to Westward 10 at. 11 Wind halled to West and Little up 3 at. 11 all ice ahead as far as we can see backed Ship Steady N. E. by N. at Last Shorten Sail Laying off and on so ends these 24 hours

Tuesday May 24th 1859

Ice Comes in With Fresh Gale from West and Clear heading to Southward under Dub reefs Lay the More Moderate Made all Sail steering North 5 at. 11 Made fog island a beam to windward ice all day to West 10 at. 11 Shot in Thick Shorten Sail Laying off and on the ice 2 Ships in situ Wind and latter part Little wind and thick fog Lay off and on the ice so ends these 24 hours

Wednesday May 25th

Ice Comes With Little Wind from West and Low Bow head island Bearing East run in for North Shore till it got very thick Shorten Sail heading off then got up the big chain and bent it
