

Friday June 3 / 1859
Tascos With very little winds from South
First part very thick all 4 boats off
cruising for whales mid and latter
part Little Winds and fine weather
So ends these 24 hours

Saturday June 4th
These 24 hours very little Wind from
East and thick fog Ship staying in
San West Bay Boats off Whaling So ends

Sunday June 5th
First part no Wind and thick
fog mid and latter part Wood thin
from S. W. and clear Saw some Whales
Boats off Whaling But could not strike
Ship to anchor in San West Bay So ends

Monday June 6th
First part Calm and fine weather
6.4. c. b. got under weigh bound up
to San West Bay mid fresh Breeze from
S. W. Lat part Wood Winds from West

Tuesday June 7th / 59
Comes in With Little Breeze from S. W.
and thick fog mid Calm and thick
fog 2 P. M. anchored with 40 fathoms and rope in
37 fathoms Water 6 P. M. Cleared up hove
up and run down to Long beach and
anchored in 15 fathoms So ends these 24 hours

Wednesday June 8th / 59
Tascos With very little Winds from S. W.
and fine weather Ship to anchor off
Long beach Boats off Whaling Saw some
Whales

Thursday June 9 / 1859
First part Calm and pleasant weather
1 P. M. Moderate Breeze from S. W.
Boats off Whaling Saw No Whales took
our anchor bound to Westward latter
part the same Working out by fogish
So ends these 24 hours

Friday June 10th
Comes in With little Winds from S. E.
and fine weather Course S. W. mid
Calm latter part Little Winds from
S. W. Steering West So ends these 24 hours

Saturday June 11th
Comes in With Little Winds from
S. E. Course West mid Little
from East latter part Calm and
fine weather So ends these 24 hours

Sunday June 12th
Tascos With very Little Winds from
S. W. and good weather 2 P. M.
Come to anchor in 3 Brother Bay
Lowered all the boats and cruised
for Whales but saw none So ends these

Monday June 13th
Tascos With good weather and
Calm Boats off cruising for Whales
Ship to anchor in 3 brother Bay one
Ship and big staying in here
So ends these 24 hours
