

Tuesday June 14th 1859
Pascas With Light winds from S.W.
and thick fog. Ship to anchor in
3 Brothers bay in 21 fathoms water
So ends these 24 hours

Wednesday June 15th
Comes in With Light Winds from
S.W. and Cloudy & A.M. here
up our anchor and made sail bound
to Westward & P.M. spoke bark battar
of chew led for hauled in Shoreward
as ked in 11 fathoms latter part no
wind so boats off cruising for Whales
So ends these 24 hours

Thursday June 16th /59
Comes in With Light Breezes from
South and Cloudy & A.M. got under
Way bound to Westward latter part no
wind come to anchor again in 10 fathoms
water 3 boats off cruising for Whales

Friday June 17th
Comes in With Light Winds from East
and Cloudy & P.M. got under Way
bound S.E.W. Mid the same latter
part show winds and raining all
night out So ends these 24 hours

Saturday June 18th
Pascas With Strong Breezes from N.E.
and Cloudy course S.E.W. Mid and
latter part the same course S.W.E.
So ends these 24 hours

Sunday June 19th /59
Comes in With Moderate Breezes from N.E.
and Cloudy course S.W.E. Mid the
same latter part calm Sea by 3.30 P.M.
& P.M. made Land a head dis 22 miles
here Land and got 40 fathoms So ends

Monday June 20th
Pascas With Light Winds from S.W.
and fine Weather Saghalind Gulf
Cape Maria bearing S.S.E. dis 10 miles
latter very Light winds and very strong
current setting out dropt our anchor in
30 fathoms water Cloud up and layed
all night So ends these 24 hours

Tuesday June 21st /59
Comes in With fresh breezes from S.West
and fine Weather & A.M. got under
Way bound in to Saghalind Gulf
Mid and latter part the same catch
come up to see Shorter Gail and layed
off and on spoke bark North America
Saw one Whale So ends these 24 hours

Wednesday June 22nd
Comes in With Light Winds from S.W.
and fine Weather Lay off the ice saw
6 or 7 Whales bound and chased all day
Whales very shy Mid and latter part
Calm So ends these 24 hours

Thursday June 23rd /59
Comes in With fresh Breezes from S.E.
Mid and latter part calm laying off and
on the ice heard the bay full of ice
So ends these 24 hours
