S.W. and Fine Weather all Hands
employed Storing down and cleaning
Boat Mid Calm Latter part Strong
Winds from S.E. 2 Boats off to ends

Saturday July 23rd
First part Fresh gales from S.W.
and thick Mid Lite Winds and
Fine Weather Boats off Cruising for
Whale Ship to anchor off South Head Latter
Part Calm So Ends this day

Sunday July 24th
First part Lite Winds from S.E.
and rain Mid Fresh Gale Latter
Part The Same Boats off Cruising for
Whales but Saw none So end this day

Monday July 25th
Comes in With Fresh gales from
S.E. and Cloudy Mid Lite Winds
and fine Weather Boats off Cruising
Latter part the same So Ends

Tuesday July 26th
Comes in With Fine Weather and
Calm N.E. & M. Left South Head
Bound to Striped Bluff to Wood and
Water Mid Lite Winds from S.E.
Latter part fresh gales and fine
Weather Come to anchor off Striped
bluff So ends this day

Wednesday July 27th
First part Calm and fine Weather
Mid Lite Winds from S.E. getting
off Wood and Water Latter part very
Moderate 40 Ships in site so ends this

Thursday July 28th
Pases With Lite Winds from S.E.
and Fine Weather Laying to Striped
Bluff getting off Wood and Water
Saw one Whale So ends this day

Friday July 29th
Comes in With Lite Breezes from
S.E. and Fine Weather took anchor
Bound off in the Bay on a Cruise
Mid the Same Latter part Lite Wind
and Thick anchored off Striped Bluff
in 15 fathoms So Ends there 24 hours

Saturday July 30th
Comes in With Lite Breezes from
S.W. and thick fog Mid and
Latter part Calm and Pleasant
Boats off Whaling Struck one and
took him along side and cut him
So ends this day

Sunday July 31st
Pases With Lite Winds from
South and fine Weather Boats off
Whaling Struck one and took him
along side So ends this 24 hours
