Thursday Aug 25th
Comes in With Calm Weather and
Pleasant Mid and Latter part
First half from S.W. Laying to anchor
in S.W. Bay With big anchor down
and fathoms of Chain a head Boats
off Chasing for Whales Go ends

Friday Aug 26th
Passes With fresh Breeze from S.W.
and Pleasant Weather Boats off
Whaling Thunk one and took him
a long Tide and cut him Go Ends

Saturday Aug 27th
Passes With Little Winds from S.W.
and Fine Weather Boats off Whaling
Thunk one and lost him Go Ends

Sunday Aug 28th
Comes in With fine Weather and Calm
Mid and Latter part fresh Breeze
from S.W. Boats off Whaling Thunk
one and took him along side and
cut him Go ends this day

Monday Aug 29th
Passes With fresh Breezes from S.W.
and fine Weather Boats off Cruising
Men employed Boiling Huber
Go Ends this day

Tuesday Aug 30th
Comes in With fine Weather and
Calm Mid fresh Breezes from S.W.
Latter part Calm Boats off Chasing
Whales Men employed Boiling Go ends

Wednesday Aug 31st
Comes in With Little Winds
from S.W. and good Weather
Boats off at home 2 Boats
Come a board and towed down
Mid and Latter part the
Same Go Ends these 24 hours
