

Remarks On Board of

Ship Cincinnati

Saturday Sept 10th 1859
First Part fresh Breezes from N.E.
Mid and latter part calm. Boats
of Cruising for Whales to Ends this day

Thursday Sept 15th
Comes in Strong Gale from N.E.
With rain Working in Shore under
Short Sail. Mid the same latter
part No. Material Wind N.E.
Course N.E. By E. to ends the 24th hours

Sunday Sept 11th
Comes in With Light Winds from S.W.
and Good Weather. A.M. have up
anchor Round down With Shore Mid.
and latter part calm. Come to
Anker Saw a few Whales. Toward
End Chased to Ends this day

Friday Sept 16th
Comes in With Fresh Breezes from
N.E. and Clear bedding N.E. & E.
Mid moderate latter part Fresh Gale
A heavy Squall leaving from N.E.
3 Ships in File Steering to Northward
to Ends these 24 hours

Monday Sept 12th
Comes in With Winds from East
and Cloudy. A.M. get under weigh
at and Worked out Mid. Strong
Gale from N.E. and rainy kept
off and run in to N.E. Harbor
and come to anchor. Latter part
Strong Gale and rainy. to ends

Saturday Sept 17th
Passes With fresh Gale from N.E.
and Clear Weather Ship under Short
Sail Working to Northward all we
can to Ends these 24 hours

Tuesday Sept 13th 1859
Comes in With fresh Breezes from
Northward and rainy. men employed
getting off a raft Water Mid.
and latter part calm. Laying in
N.E. Harbor in company With 4 Ships

Sunday Sept 18th
Comes in With fresh Gale from
Northward and rainy. Mid the
same latter part more moderate
Working to Northward all we can
Lat 56-06 to ends this day

Wednesday Sept 14th
Comes in With Light Winds from
West and fine Weather at day Late
have up and made sail bound down
N. Shore Mid. Fresh Breezes all Sail
out 3 P.M. Saw 1 Whale off Brooks
Point Lowest. Chased latter part
Fresh Gale from N.E. and rainy

Monday, Sept 19th
Comes in With Strong Gale from
N.E. Ship under Short Sail heading
off By the West Mid and South
Lat to some 10 P.M. Now Steady
heading N. By E. to end this day
