

Tuesday September 20th 1859
Comes in with strong gales from
S.E. and Bad Weather under Short
Gail heading in Shore on the Wind
and Latter part the same Wind
Ship at 6 P.M. heading E.S.E.
So ends the day

Wednesday. Sept. 21st
Comes in with fresh gales from
S.E. and clear weather and light
winds and good weather all sail
out standing in Shore on the Wind
Latter part calm Land Dis 25 Miles
Lat by obs 56-30 North So ends

Thursday Sept. 22nd
Comes in with light weather and
calm mid light winds from North
Latter part calm S.E. So ends

Friday Sept. 23rd
Comes in with light winds from S.W.
and fine weather steering S.E. mid
More Wind all sail out Latter part
the same Lat by obs 57.08 North
North Shore in Lat Dis 25 Miles So ends

Saturday Sept. 24th
Comes in with light winds from
S.W. and fine weather course S.E. day
light headed in Shore and run the
Land down Latter part laying off
and on Ochotsk City 3 Ships in
Sit. but no Whales So ends this day

Sunday, Sept. 25th 1859
Comes in with fresh breezes from
S.W. and raining at sea but near
Moderate headed in Shore and
Latter part day fair from Alaska
Tiger and 1 bow head lowered chain
 spoke Ship May Prarie and Casco
off Star Bedford mid Latter
part strong winds from S.W. under
Short Gail laying off and on
Ochotsk City Beach So ends these 25

Monday. Sept. 26th
Comes in with fresh breezes from
S.W. and clear laying off and
on under Short Gail 40 fathoms come
to anchor off Ochotsk City at some
altitude and here up again and
run down the coast. Shore to North
Saw a few Whales lowered and
checked mid and Latter part
light winds and good weather
C.P.M. come to anchor off North Shore
in 14 fathoms So ends this day

Tuesday Sept. 27th
Comes in with fresh gales from
S.E. and cloudy 4. P.M. here
in arka and stood off Shore under
Short Gail bound for Sandwich
Island Latter part strong gales
and raining at 12 Noon Ship heading
S.E. by E Nothing more our watch
Attention
