 155-14 West Go Ends then 24 hours

Tuesday, Nov. 1/39
 Comes in With Light Winds
 from S.S.W and fine Weather Mid
 the Same Latter part Wind N.S.W
 and squally Course S. by E
 Lat by obs 28-47 N Long 154-30
 Go Ends then 24 hours

Wednesday, Nov. 2/1839
 Comes in With Light Winds from
 Westward all Sail set Steering S. by E
 Mid and Latter part Light Winds
 from Southward and fine Weather bearing
 S. East and S.S. Stud Sails Course
 South Saw a Ship off our Starboard
 quarter Lat by obs 27-22 N Long 153-34

Thursday, Nov. 3rd
 Passes With Light Winds from
 Eastward and fine Weather all Sail
 set First part and Mid Steering
 South Latter S. by W Saw a Ship
 a stern going same as us Lat
 by obs 23-32 N Long 154-19 West

Friday, Nov. 4/39
 Comes in With Light Winds from
 Southward and fine Weather Mid
 Wind S.E Latter part Wind E.S.E
 Course S. by W Lat by obs 24-18 West
 Long 154-48 West Go Ends

Saturday, Nov. 5/39
 Passes With Moderate breezes from
 Southward and fine Weather Working
 to Windward all these 24 hours
 Lat by obs 23-15 N Long 153-32 West
 6 Ships in Sight all heading to Windward
 Go Ends then 24 hours
